# What is a Casenote Competition?

- A casenote is a scholarly report of a recent and significant decision
- Journal competition is for 1Ls who have completed their first year of study
- Each applicant applies to be an editor of one or more journals
- Application is submitted online

# How did we get here?

- Nine Journals @ Duke Law
- Existing editors read the casenotes and grade it
- Recently, process was done by hand
- Had to automate process
- Used NYU and Georgetown as a benchmark

# What's the solution?

- Created online pages to gather and distribute application packages
- Technology used :
  - o a Linux sever with an Apache Web Server installed
  - o MySQL database on another Linux server
  - PHP and HTML

- two outgoing law students
- o Two second year editors
- Staff members
- o Web Services, including Paul as programmer/DBA
